

Prospectus Special Education Educational Specialist Program

The Educational Specialist (EdS) Degree of Special Education is designed for those seeking an advanced practitioner's degree in the area of special education. This is a terminal degree; not an interim step between the master's and doctoral degrees. The EdS program requires a minimum of 60 graduate semester hours (that include the master's degree coursework, 30 of which must be completed at KSU), beyond the baccalaureate degree. You may work for an Intervention Specialist Licensure in the state of Ohio through the course of this program, but the hours required for licensure may exceed those required for the EdS Degree. Candidates must complete the EdS degree program within 5 years from the term of first enrollment.
